KINGWOOD tracked the leaders outside a rival off the second flight in the opening quarter, shifted out three deep entering the bend commencing a steady advance, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch while moving to challenge in tandem with MY JOKESTER and produced a steady late response to wrest command and kick clear in time under firm handling. The latter settled into last racing well off the inside, advanced to contention four wide on the turn, was fanned five wide entering the lane while moving to challenge in tandem with the winner but couldn't quite match strides with that one late. SILKEN BO sped clear soon after the start while angling sharply to the inside, turned back a challenge racing into upper stretch to maintain the advantage past midstretch but was collared by the top pair late. JOHN GALT tracked off the second flight along the inside in tandem with the eventual winner in the opening quarter, advanced to contention along the rail racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. FAITHFUL SERVANT, urged to gain a forward placing outside rivals tracking the pacesetter, moved to lodge a brief bid for command nearing upper stretch but came up empty leaving midstretch. CADCAM was urged to gain brief contention between foes pursuing the pacesetter racing to the turn but was spent early.
