Footnotes

ST. LOUIE SLEW, prominent three deep attending the pace in the opening stages, was prompted to dictate the tempo while shifting to the inside approaching the half mile marker, angled to the rail entering the bend while disputing the issue inside a rival racing on her own courage, regained the advantage entering upper stretch and drew well clear in the closing stages under strong handling. PYLORTES, in touch with the leaders between foes while under light rating in the opening stages, lost ground to the leader racing through the turn, then was roused while shifting to the inside in upper stretch, continuing with interest to the end edge a rival for second in late stages. MEGHAN'S FAITH shifted out four wide in the opening furlong while being prompted to advance on the leaders, forced the pace outside the eventual winner racing into the turn to strike the front between calls, couldn't match the winner after a half and drifted out late. TAPIT TIME ducked out at the start, settled into stride racing out of striking distance and never gained contention. DEAR HRISHI, in touch with the leaders along the rail in the opening stages, steadily faded from contention nearing upper stretch.
