### Footnotes

VALID PRIME lacked speed from off the rail, began moving up turning for home, found his way through traffic in the stretch and was along in time. SUAVE GENTLEMAN set the pace from the inside while pressed, drifted out in the stretch and just failed to hold off the winner. HOMEM RA went up to press the pace from off the rail, remained close throughout and weakened a bit in the run to the wire. EVERWHAT raced off the rail near the middle of the field and failed to respond when asked. AMERICAN LINK raced off the rail at the middle of the field, was never a factor and his rider lost the whip in upper stretch. SWEET WATER RIM was hustled up inside and dropped back steadily. PURPLEST raced near the middle of the field, checked on the backstretch and gave way. GATURRO (ARG) saved ground but was always outrun.
