VICTORINA was allowed to settle in three wide near the middle of the field, was asked to pick it up in upper stretch, rallied to the lead near the furlong marker and drew off under a brisk hand ride. GRANDELENA was content to stalk the pace from off the rail and gave her best in the stretch while no match for the winner. DIRTY RUSH broke sharply to the lead, set all of the pace while away from the rail, could not handle the winner in the drive and lost the place late. MY CHICKADEE was unruly in the post parade, steadied inside in the early going and lacked a rally. MORE THAN PRETTY lacked speed along the inside and failed to reach a contending position. READYFORCOCKTAILS was bumped at the start and was never a factor. LAMPOON was always outrun while racing three to four wide.
