Footnotes

JOE VANN was prompted to secure terms with a rival on the lead racing into the first turn, attended that foe's tempo unhurried racing to the second bend, wrested command midway through the far turn, shifted to the rail in upper stretch and steadily extended his advantage under energetic handling. ZOEBEAR was guided to the rail early racing well out of striking distance, continued unhurried to the second bend, shifted off the inside to split foes nearing upper stretch, switched out three deep nearing the furlong marker and continued with interest to edge a rival for place honors. THE FED EASED tracked just off and outside the first flight under light rating in the opening half, advanced to challenge three deep racing through the far turn but failed to match terms with the winner nearing the furlong marker and was outfinished for second. SOUR secured position between foes racing just off the second flight while under light rating, made some brief progress while angled out nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. EL GRAYLING raced under some reserve three deep behind the second flight into the backstretch, continued in that path racing into the far turn, was fanned four wide racing into upper stretch and continued between foes in an even effort. WATCH ME GO, brushed at the start, gained a position in the second flight along the inside racing into the first turn, shifted out entering the backstretch, raced four deep into the far turn and steadily faded from contention. ROMAN FLAME was settled three deep between foes in the opening half, made an effort to improve position in that path racing into the stretch but made no impression. LAGOON OF DIAMONDS broke readily, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the inside racing into the far turn but gave way abruptly midway through the second bend. VOUCH FOR VICTORY broke inwards, worked his way to the inside while settling out of striking distance and never mounted a serious challenge. SMARTER THAN EVER tracked off the second flight along the inside into the backstretch but steadily faded after a half. SOUTHERN SCULPTOR, reserved in hand racing off the inside to the backstretch, never seriously menaced. FUTURE EMPIRE was settled outside foes racing to the first turn and proved no

factor.
