ROBBIN LYNN raced close up off the rail, rallied in the final furlong and was along at the wire. PROUD TO DANCE set the pace from the inside and resisted gamely in the stretch but could not last. PIXIE POO raced inside near the middle of the field and came up the rail to challenge in the stretch but lacked a winning bid. ACCEPT DOMRA raced five wide on the first turn, lacked speed and improved her position. PEYTONS PLEASURE raced close up three wide and weakened. KISSIN BEAUTY raced off the rail near the middle of the field and gave. SHIRANO was carried out on the first turn and saved ground while outrun. STARSHIP GARNET was four wide on the first turn and was through after a half.
