SLEWZOOM, in close attendance to the pace racing along the rail to the first turn, shifted off the inside when losing his path to the pacesetter on the first turn while a bit rank and momentarily impeding INDIAN TALK, was wrangled back to stalk the leader along the inside to the far turn, awaited an opening leaving the second bend, shifted out four wide in upper stretch, then reeled in the leader to prevail under firm handling. FIRE CLOUD, bumped by SPARE ME TEN at the start, was held up off the leaders in the opening stages, made steady progress outside foes to gain striking position three deep leaving the far turn, wrested command in upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. BUD SYMONDS was reserved along the inside in the opening half, swung out four wide racing into upper stretch and steadily improved his position. IRON CHAMP tracked the leaders outside rivals racing as part of the second flight in the opening half but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. INDIAN TALK, urged to a forward placing, was carried out a bit by the winner racing through the turn, stalked just off the pacesetter to the second bend, lodged a brief bid outside that foe on the far turn but flattened out in the drive. SMARTY MOUTH broke awkwardly, was steadied a bit when racing in close quarters entering the first turn, continued unhurried for a half, then made some belated progress outside foes racing into the lane. HART OF A COWBOY sped to the lead while angling over on the first turn, dictated the pace to the far turn, then emptied out in upper stretch. SPARE ME TEN broke out, bumped FIRE CLOUD, was reserved near the inside to the backstretch, then steadily faded from contention.
