LEMONDROPSPRITZER secured a forward placing near the inside while conceding the lead to a rival in the opening stages, continued with a steady bid while shifting outside the pacesetter racing into the bend while commencing her advance, moved to wrest command nearing midstretch and drew clear late under firm encouragement. TANITH was hustled to the lead from the break, set the pace on a clear margin a bit off the rail racing into the bend, briefly resisted the winner's bid racing into upper stretch but proved no match for that foe late. BLARNEY D'OR broke outwards bumping SECRET GLITTER, was righted to track just off the leaders in the three path racing into the bend, continued between foes in that path to upper stretch to prevail for a share but lacked the needed final kick. COURTESY CALL settled into stride out of striking distance along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch and gained some position in an even effort. SECRET GLITTER, bumped at the start, was righted to track just off the leaders racing four wide into the turn, continued in that path to upper stretch and steadily faded in the drive. PARTY VISION broke slowly, was outdistanced after a half, then was pulled up by her rider and vanned off the course.
