Footnotes

DENIM worked his way to the inside stalking just off the leaders in hand racing to the first turn, continued in hand to the far turn, came through inside foes to challenge the pacesetter when presented an opening in upper stretch, then reeled in the leader in the final stages to prevail under firm encouragement. ECONOMIC BAILOUT broke readily, dictated the pace along the inside under light rating, shook clear in upper stretch and grudgingly yielded to the winner. THE ALCOVA KID, a bit rank under restraint between foes in the opening stages, swung out four wide leaving the far turn and continued willingly for a share. SPIDER POWER (IRE) reserved along the rail in the opening half, shifted off the inside entering upper stretch, split foes and continued willingly between rivals to the end. MINISTER'S JOY, reserved racing off the inside to the backstretch, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and had no final response. GIANT SHIFT tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside to the backstretch but came up empty in the drive. S. M. W. KAITLYN, prominent outside foes in the opening stages, stalked just outside the pacesetter for a half, lodged a brief bid racing through the far turn, drifted out in upper stretch and quickly gave way.
