CAP'N NICK broke outwards, was quickly righted to gain terms with the leaders racing four wide on the backstretch, moved to command racing three deep into upper stretch, then steadily widened his advantage while being kept to the task. HEART FULL OF SOUL broke out, bumped SHARP ROMA, was hustled clear of the field along the rail racing to the bend, couldn't answer the winner but gamely turned back a rival to prevail for the place. NITPICKER tracked the leaders unhurried from just out of striking distance early, then continued willingly racing off the inside to gain a share in late stages. ROI LE ROY, never far back, moved to challenge the pacesetter racing through the turn, gained terms with that rival nearing upper stretch but flattened out in late stages. SHARP ROMA, bumped at the start, was righted to track the leaders along the inside racing to upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. CORNEL NOBLE, shuffled back at the start, never seriously menaced. BIG BAD MIKE ducked outwards at the start and soon dropped out. OUTLAW ZEN broke slowly and trailed throughout.
