Footnotes

CASHA sped to the lead while angling to the inside, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin racing into the bend, shifted out in upper stretch and held sway to the end under steady encouragement. ZIPPY TRIP stalked the pacesetter under light rating off the inside racing into the bend and continued willingly between foes to the end to prevail for second. SWEET COOL tracked just off the first flight in the opening stages, angled to the rail after the opening quarter, moved to challenge inside the leaders racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. LIGHT EM UP RICH broke inwards, was righted to track off the second flight, shifted to the inside racing into the turn and continued evenly into the stretch. AUTUMN SPLENDOR stumbled at the start, was urged to gain a position in the second flight racing to the turn but offered no closing bid. MS FOUREIGHTWONINE settled near the inside early but never gained contention. CHICKEN JUICE, steadied out of tight quarters just after the start, settled in last and never menaced thereafter.
