Footnotes

LOVE TRIAL, within striking distance outside foes in the opening stages tracking the pace, moved to challenge midway through the bend racing three deep between foes, continued to dispute the issue in that path inside a rival past midstretch and edged clear under steady handling. A BRUSH OF BEAUTY, reserved off the first flight outside foes in the opening stages, lodged a solid, four wide bid nearing upper stretch, struck the front approaching the furlong marker but couldn't match terms with the winner in the final sixteenth. ANYONESHOME, held up just off the first flight a bit off the inside in the opening stages, shifted out on the turn to race four wide into upper stretch and continued in that path to prevail for a share. SATIN SWEEP, urged to dispute the pace along the rail soon after the break, duelled for command into upper stretch but weakened nearing the furlong marker. SNEAKY BUNNIE was urged to duel for command between foes racing into the bend near the inside but gave way early. KITTY COVENANT broke sharply to force the pace three deep racing into the bend and gave way nearing midstretch. NORMANSBIRDIE, caught five wide in the opening stages, retreated from contention early.
