Footnotes

JUNIOR'S BOOST TOO was reserved in hand saving ground in the opening half, commenced a steady advance entering the far turn, swung five wide nearing upper stretch while moving to challenge the leaders, then turned back a challenge from JINGLE JANGLE while shifting inwards racing through the stretch to edge clear under brisk right handed encouragement. The latter, bumped at the start, was settled well off the inside racing to the backstretch, continued outside foes racing into the second bend gathering momentum, swung six wide nearing upper stretch moving in tandem with the eventual winner to challenge for command, struck the front near midstretch but was outfinished. INEXCESSIVE SUE settled well off the field in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn, was fanned seven wide into upper stretch and made some mild progress while edging a rival for a share. GIBBY'S TORNADO, urged to a contending position four deep racing to the first turn, was eased off the first flight racing into the backstretch to track those foes along the inside, shifted out on the far turn to lodge a brief, four wide bid nearing upper stretch but failed to sustain that effort through the final quarter. GREAT BAM broke readily to join the pace outside a rival racing into the backstretch, pressed the issue between foes into upper stretch and gave way leaving midstretch. DEAL OF A LIFETIME broke outwards bumping JINGLE JANGLE, was righted to stalk just off the first flight three deep racing into the backstretch, moved to challenge in that path racing through the far turn but gave way in upper stretch. BRAID tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight in the opening half but never mounted a serious challenge. MADILLAC D'VILLE was urged to dispute the pace along the inside racing into the first turn, pressed the issue inside foes to the second bend and gave way nearing upper stretch. NO MORE TALKIN was urged to gain a position in the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch but retreated from contention early.
