Footnotes

AMAZING BUD was urged to force the pace outside a rival from the break, gained a clear lead between calls racing through the turn while angling to the rail, was roused to turn back a challenge in upper stretch and drew off under steady encouragement. SPREAD THE CHIPS, forwardly placed along the rail contesting the pace in the opening stages, relinquished the lead after the opening quarter to stalk the pacesetter in hand, shifted out entering the bend to make a second bid nearing upper stretch but couldn't match the winner in the final quarter while holding well enough for second. WICKED LOVER broke outwards bumping LOVIE BEAR, was righted to track the leaders off the inside in second flight, steadied in close quarters while shifting into the path of LOVIE BEAR entering the bend, then continued evenly three deep racing into the stretch to earn a share. HUSTLIN BOBBY was guided to the inside in early stages tracking the leaders from well out of striking distance, saved ground on the turn while moving to contention, altered course avoiding tight quarters in upper stretch and continued evenly to late stages. IDEAL ALLUVIAL exchanged some contact with LOVIE BEAR at the start, was settled well off the leaders four wide in early stages, shifted in to split foes racing through the turn, angled inwards entering upper stretch while crossing the path of HUSTLIN BOBBY and had no final kick. KATHY'S MAN, reserved off the inside in the opening stages, never gained striking distance. LOVIE BEAR, bumped, then jostled between foes at the start, was urged to position three deep in the second flight, was forced out racing into the turn, continued five deep into upper stretch and steadily faded from contention.
