Footnotes

MONGOL MAX, forwardly placed stalking just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, made steady progress racing into upper stretch to challenge that foe, shifted out under pressure racing past midstretch but edged clear late under firm encouragement. APPLTATACORNTAMATA broke sharply to gain the advantage, dictated the pace along the inside racing into the bend, resisted the winner's bid to late stages but proved only second best. BACKDOC broke slowly, was urged to gain a position inside a rival tracking off the leaders in second flight racing into the bend, saved ground to upper stretch and was making mild progress late. FRIENDIAN settled in last racing well off the rail in the opening quarter, angled out racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position while failing to menace the leaders. PULP tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, then angled to the inside on the turn while steadily retreating from contention. GOLDSWISH was a brief factor outside foes tracking the leaders in the second flight but emptied out racing into upper stretch.
