AWESOME BREW angled inwards a bit in the opening stages to gain terms with the second flight while between foes, tracked the leaders unhurried while saving some ground on the bend, shifted out three wide in upper stretch to challenge, then wrested command from ON THE SNEAK in the final sixteenth to prevail under firm encouragement. The latter, off a step behind the leaders, moved to join the pacesetter outside rivals in the opening stages, pressed that foe while exchanging some contact in upper stretch, resisted the winner's bid but couldn't fend off that rival late. R RICH E. RICH tracked just off the leaders racing three wide in second flight early, swung out four wide in upper stretch and finished evenly while earning a share. CANAVERAL RIDE broke sharply, disputed the pace along the rail racing into the bend, exchanged some contact with ON THE SNEAK in upper stretch, then weakened in late stages. RULER OF THE COURT stalked just off the leaders along the rail racing to the bend, then came up empty after a half. SPY HUNTER was eased back out of close quarters soon after the break, shifted outside foes tracking the pace, was fanned five wide in upper stretch but had no closing bid. ZAVILL was settled along the inside early but offered no rally.
