RECTOR broke a bit awkwardly, was reserved just off the first flight racing into the backstretch, angled inwards to stalk the leaders outside a rival entering the far turn, switched out four wide when given his cue leaving the quarter mile marker to challenge, quickly moved to command and went clear under steady hand urging. LEMON CUSTARD joined the pace four wide racing into the backstretch, pressed the issue three deep on the far turn but proved no match when confronted by the winner. TIMELESS FACTS was urged to join the pace along the rail racing to the backstretch, dropped back off the leaders on the far turn, then shifted out racing into upper stretch to make a second effort to gain a share four deep in late stages. CALZONE was urged to dispute the pace three deep between foes into the backstretch, continued to dispute the issue between foes on the far turn and gave way nearing midstretch after his rider lost his whip. SHIP'S CABIN prompted the pace between foes racing into the backstretch, dueled along the rail racing through the far turn and gave way in upper stretch.
