Footnotes

BLUSHING PREACHER broke readily, gained a tracking position in the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch while racing unhurried, continued in that fashion to the midway point of the second turn, shifted off the inside to challenge three deep entering upper stretch, moved to command and extended his advantage to the end under some left handed encouragement. LARKFLITE secured a forward placing outside the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, tracked that rival under light rating to the far turn, moved to challenge nearing upper stretch, had no response for the winner's bid but grudgingly prevailed for place honors. LO ME was urged to gain a clear advantage while angling over racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a clear margin just off the inside into the second bend, couldn't contain the winner and weakened leaving midstretch while contesting second to late stages. NO PASSAGE, caught in tight quarters four deep racing into the first turn, was held up off the second flight while angling to the inside on the bend, commenced his advance while shifting out midway through the second bend, split foes in upper stretch and continued to improve his position to the end. AIRTIGHT tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, angled out four wide leaving the far turn while being roused to challenge, swerved out nearing the furlong marker and had no further response. RENO RIDGE, caught five deep racing to the first turn, was reserved a bit to track off the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued outside foes into the second bend and never gained striking distance. MALIBU VICE, allowed to settle in hand along the inside racing to the backstretch, never mounted a serious challenge. BLUE CANOE secured a position three deep in the second flight racing into the first turn, continued in that path for six furlongs and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. MING GLO, caught four wide racing to the backstretch, soon dropped out of contention.
