Footnotes

FOREST COLORS broke readily, was held up just off the first flight racing into the first turn, shifted out nearing the backstretch while moving to terms with the pacesetter, attended that foe's pace to the second bend, continued with a steady bid to wrest command racing into upper stretch and held sway on a narrow margin to the end under firm handling. CLASSIC RECITAL, forwardly placed while shifting to the inside racing into the first turn, steadied in close quarters nearing the backstretch, shifted outside foes to track in second flight racing to the far turn, swung four wide racing into upper stretch while being urged to advance and closed the gap in that path to the end while narrowly prevailing for place honors. BINGORUN was urged to join the pace while shifting in to the three path racing into the first turn, gained a narrow advantage after the opening quarter, dictated the pace into the second bend, continued to resist the winner's bid past midstretch but was outfinished. RUNAWAY CAL was urged to terms with the first flight while between foes racing into the first turn, ceded the lead to a rival to track that foe along the inside into the second bend, shifted out in upper stretch and continued willingly between foes to the end while just missing for a share. SCAPPARE tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted out five wide racing through the stretch and made some mild progress in that path late. UNCHARTEDTERRITORY tracked off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch,

saved ground to upper stretch and continued nearest the rail to late stages while making mild progress. DEGREES OF BRAD tracked off the second flight outside foes racing to the far turn, angled six wide in upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. SOMEWHERE IN TIME was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. SIR KIPLING tracked the pace outside foes off the second flight early, was caught four wide racing into the far turn and offered no rally. BARANIT never seriously menaced. STATE PARK was a brief factor four wide in the second flight racing to the backstretch but retreated from contention early. BIG AS A BARN showed little.
