**Footnotes**

THE PIZZA MAN was reserved well off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady advance along the rail entering the second bend, rapidly drew into striking position nearing upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker while making some contact with TENS WILD but went clear under firm right handed encouragement. EIGHT GAUGE worked his way to the rail early tracking off the first flight, gathered momentum on the far turn, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to prevail for place honors. TENS WILD, on terms with the leaders in the opening stages, was eased back to track those foes near the inside in second flight racing to the far turn, moved to challenge inside the pacesetter nearing upper stretch, exchanged some contact nearing the furlong marker, couldn't match the winner and was outfinished for second. MONTANA KID settled outside foes well off the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out six wide racing through the stretch and made a belated effort to close the gap. ITALIAN BREEZE, caught wide racing into the first turn, continued off the second flight racing into the far turn but offered no rally. PERFECTLY AT HOME was urged to the lead along the inside racing to the backstretch, set the pace into the far turn and emptied out abruptly entering upper stretch. CAPTAIN AMERICAN tracked the leaders three deep in second flight in the opening half, made a brief bid between foes racing in that path

through the far turn but flattened out in upper stretch. BRIM tracked off the second flight under reserve in the opening half, shifted out four wide entering the second bend while looming boldly, but emptied out abruptly in the drive. PERKS, a bit slow into stride, tracked the leaders along the inside to the far turn but lacked a rally. IOLANDA'S PERFECT, reserved to the far turn, never seriously menaced. LEAL RIDGE was never a factor. CHAS THE MAN was urged to join the pace outside foes racing to the backstretch but was through after a half.
