Footnotes

COPUS broke readily to gain terms with the first flight three deep racing into the first turn, attended the pace on his own courage to the second bend, steadily moved to command in that path nearing upper stretch and was roused clear racing through the lane. FUN ON THE BAYOU, reserved along the inside in last racing to the backstretch, switched outside foes midway through the backstretch, swung five wide racing into upper stretch while making steady progress and proved best of the others. PRICELESS SHORE tracked just off the first flight in the opening half under rating, moved to challenge four wide racing through the far turn but lacked the needed final kick. BOSCO RULES joined the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes into the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. BLUSHING PREACHER was urged to dispute the pace inside foes racing into the first turn, dueled for command into the far turn and gave way nearing midstretch. SAILING ALONG, reserved near the inside in the opening stages, never gained contention. SLLIM SREVA was settled out of some traffic in the opening stages to race along the inside from just out of striking distance but steadily faded on the far turn. GHETTO CAT settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never seriously menaced.
