Footnotes

HURTA moved to the fore along the inside to dispute the lead racing to the backstretch, edged forward to a narrow advantage after a half, shook clear racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. PART'N PARCEL, caught four wide into the first turn, made steady progress outside foes to gain contention on the far turn and prevailed for second. MILWAUKEE WOLF tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight, shifted out in upper stretch and was just outfinished for second. OPTIMER (ARG) tracked the pace between foes off the second flight, shifted out leaving the far turn and continued evenly into the stretch. BIG BEAR HUG settled off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening stages, split foes racing into upper stretch and continued willingly between foes to late stages. TURNPIKE TOMMY tracked off the second flight along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. GO DOUG GO tracked the pace outside foes off the second flight in the opening half, was fanned five wide into upper stretch and finished evenly. SWIFT PROGRESS settled well off the field early and never gained contention. CHARBOURG was never a factor. HUCKLEBERRY BOY went up to force the pace outside a rival from the outset and emptied out racing through the far turn. BURGAN RULES was pulled up entering the backstretch, then was vanned off the course.
