JOHNNIES BREEZE was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival soon after the break, dueled for command into upper stretch, edged forward nearing the furlong marker and drew clear late under firm right handed encouragement. THIEF tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight in the opening stages, shifted out after the opening furlong while continuing as part of the second flight, angled out four wide leaving the turn and continued with a steady bid to secure place honors late. FOXIE'S BOY went up from the break to prompt the pace outside a rival, dueled for command into upper stretch but weakened when failing to match terms with the winner in the last furlong. GO DOUG GO angled inwards gaining a position in the second flight in the opening stages, continued evenly along the inside racing into upper stretch but had no closing response. HELLO SAILOR settled off the second flight in the opening stages while working his way to the inside and offered no rally. WAXING broke awkwardly losing position to the field and trailed throughout.
