Footnotes

FLEET ENCOUNTER, within striking distance three deep in the opening stages stalking the leaders, steadily moved on terms with the first flight in that path racing through the turn, gained a clear advantage nearing the furlong marker and drew away under firm encouragement. JUST LOLA secured a contending position four deep in the opening quarter, continued in that path on the turn to upper stretch while making steady progress and proved best of the others. TELMA, reserved four deep out of striking position in the opening stages, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and made mild progress to the end while earning a share. POCANELLA tracked the pace three deep between foes from out of striking distance early and continued evenly into the stretch. GOSTOSA was settled in last racing off the inside early, shifted out nearing upper stretch and made an effort to improve position between foes racing through the stretch. DOUBLE FEVER moved to the fore along the inside to dictate the pace on a narrow margin early, dueled for command racing into the turn and gave way leaving the furlong marker. COURTESY CALL delayed proceedings when requiring a shoe repair in the paddock, tracked just off the leaders along the rail in second flight racing into the bend but steadily faded entering the stretch. FLOR MORENA, forwardly placed attending a rival's pace in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes entering the turn and gave way after a half. SANTO RIO shifted out early to gain a position between foes in the second flight racing to the turn but retreated from contention early.
