Footnotes

ROYALLY OUTFOXED was held up just off and outside the first flight racing to the turn, bid three wide for command after a half, then gamely turned back a challenge from FAMILY FACTS in the final furlong to prevail in an all out drive. The latter tracked just off the first flight along the inside early, angled four wide leaving the bend to challenge, drew on terms with the winner late but was narrowly outfinished. HEAVENLY DUE stumbled at the start, quickly recovered to prompt the pace outside a rival racing into the turn, couldn't match the top pair and weakened late. BOURBON TRAIL disputed the pace inside a rival from the break, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. ZENKAYA was settled outside foes early, raced four wide into upper stretch and never gained striking distance. GRATTAN STREET tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. EXECUTIVE COACH broke awkwardly, was righted to track the leaders off the inside racing to the bend, was pulled up leaving midstretch, then was vanned off the course.
