Footnotes

QUIET REVOLUTION angled inwards from the break to gain a forward placing, led the second flight into the backstretch racing a bit off the inside, moved in tandem with a rival to gain striking distance on the far turn, momentarily awaited a path from which to challenge, shifted out three deep in upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and pulled away under steady pressure. HOLD'EM TIGER was hustled clear of his rivals racing into the first bend, set the pace into the far turn, couldn't match the winner but held stubbornly for the place. WEEKEND PASS was settled along the inside in the opening stages, gathered some momentum shifting off the inside on the far turn, swung out four wide in upper stretch while finding his best stride and just missed the place. JOY FROM PHOENIX, caught four wide racing through the first turn tracking the pace unhurried, angled to the inside on the far turn and continued to make mild progress to the end. PEARL EXPRESS angled inside gaining some position in the second flight, shifted outside the winner after a half to race in tandem with that rival into the far run, continued with a steady bid to gain a brief lead in upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the last furlong. MICHAEL MOE stumbled at the start, was quickly righted to track the pace between foes in the second flight, continued with interest through the far turn but lacked the needed late response. CRIMINALLY INSILVER, reserved well off the pace in early stages, never seriously menaced. ADVANCED SIGNS tracked the pace between foes off the inside to the backstretch, then emptied out on the far turn. RIO ROYALE ducked outwards at the start, was quickly collected to track the pace along the inside but soon faded from contention.
