PRAIRIE BREEZE ducked inwards at the start, was collected to track along the inside, shifted out a bit into the path of ALLOW entering the first turn when racing in close quarters, continued unhurried on the backstretch, was held up out of close quarters approaching the far turn, shifted outside foes to race six wide into upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure in late stages but gamely prevailed under firm right handed pressure. HYPE, held up outside foes in the opening stages, made some progress between foes to gain contention entering the far turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch, was fanned five wide to challenge between rivals, was weaving under pressure approaching the furlong marker, lugged in sharply impeding MUSICSTREET MENACE leaving the furlong pole, continued drifting inwards while disputing the issue to the end and was narrowly outfinished. YEP shifted inwards at the start to track the pace unhurried along the inside, switched out after a half to track between foes into the far turn, awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, angled sharply to the rail when presented an opening in upper stretch, struck the front nearing the furlong marker, resisted the top pair to the end but couldn't match terms with those foes. CALZONE tracked the leaders in second flight outside a rival to the backstretch, bid between foes nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. MUSICSTREET MENACE settled into stride, was carried out a bit racing into the first turn, made a steady advance to striking distance four wide into the far turn, continued in that path to upper stretch to challenge, checked off HYPE when shut off by that rival leaving the furlong marker and soon gave way. ATHEIST was hustled to the lead racing into the first turn, dictated the pace racing well off the inside on the backstretch, continued with a clear margin to upper stretch and emptied out once headed near midstretch. ALLOW, reserved in the opening stages, was steadied out of tight quarters entering the first bend, continued unhurried for a half and never gained striking distance. COWBOY AT HEART tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight to the backstretch but steadily retreated from contention on the far turn. ONE SLICK CAT angled inwards chasing the pacesetter into the first turn, couldn't close the gap on that foe racing into the far turn, quickly gave way, was soon outdistanced, then walked off the course under his own power. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF MUSICSTREET MENACE LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF HYPE. THE STEWARDS REVIEWED THE STRETCH RUN AND DISQUALIFIED HYPE, PLACING HIM FIFTH FOR INTERFERENCE.
