TEN MOST WANTED was allowed to settle off the rail near the middle of the field, began moving up on his own courage on the second turn, took command entering the stretch and drew well off while under a mild hand ride. COLONIAL COLONY was void off speed while just off the rail, responded when asked for run turning for home and gained the place while no threat to the winner. NEW YORK HERO went up to press the pace of FLEMISH CAP from just outside, took over from that rival on the final turn then was no match for the top two in the drive. FIGHTING INDIANS trailed to the stretch then improved his position in the drive while not a danger. PARROTT BAY saved ground near the middle of the field but was never a factor. FLEMISH CAP set the pace from the inside under pressure but tired on the final turn.
