FAB A DASHER came through along the inside to secure the lead from the break despite being bumped at the start, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into turn, turned back a challenge from HAVE IT MY WAY racing into upper stretch and edged away from that foe under firm right handed encouragement to prove best. The latter was urged to terms with the leader prompting that foe racing into the bend, gained even terms with that foe on the bend to press the issue into upper stretch but came up second best in the drive. J. Z.'S CRAFTY BOY broke inwards bumping the eventual winner, was righted to track the leaders along the inside racing into the turn and continued evenly into the stretch while earning a share. SPLASHES STORM, reserved in last while shifting nearer to the inside in the opening stages, switched off the inside racing into upper stretch, shifted four wide approaching the furlong marker but had no closing bid. DANGEROUS REWARD tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, shifted out three deep nearing the half mile marker, continued in that path to upper stretch and steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
