**Footnotes**

FOREST QUEEN broke readily, dictated the pace just off the inside into the backstretch, came under right handed pressure to turn back challengers approaching the furlong marker, drifted in bumping, then clipping INSTANT STYLE, then shifted out under left handed urging to turn back a challenge from C C CERADA while exchanging some contact with that rival in the final sixteenth to narrowly prevail. The latter, reserved in hand racing off the inside to the backstretch, steadily drew into striking distance entering upper stretch, shifted out four wide to split foes nearing the furlong marker, drew on terms with the pacesetter in late stages but couldn't best that foe while being brushed late. TIMELY COMMAND, caught four wide racing into the first turn while being urged to terms with the pacesetter, pressed that rival to upper stretch and gave way. RECORDING CONTRACT, held up outside foes in the opening half, swung out four wide entering upper stretch to challenge but had no final response. LUCKY GAL, close up between foes three deep to the backstretch, tracked just off the first flight to the far turn, angled three wide nearing upper stretch but lacked any further response. OUR GIRL MAGIC was a brief factor along the inside but soon dropped out. INSTANT STYLE, reserved saving ground in the opening half, made a steady advance to contention along the rail approaching upper stretch, came through inside the pacesetter when presented an opening in upper stretch, was bumped, then clipped by that foe leaving the furlong marker and lost her rider. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN AND DISQUALIFIED FOREST QUEEN FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HER SIXTH. DUE TO A PHOTO FINISH MALFUNCTION, FINAL MARGINS WERE PROVIDED BY EQUIBASE.
