Footnotes

COME ON MAN broke sharply, took up a position attending a rival's pace under light rating racing into the bend, asserted himself nearing the furlong marker to gain a narrow advantage and drew clear late under firm handling. ENDLESS DRIVE was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival soon after the start, dueled for command into upper stretch, couldn't match the winner late but continued with interest to preserve place honors. ANY GIVEN TIME tracked the leaders in the three path as part of the second flight and continued in that path on the turn to upper stretch while finishing evenly for a share. SANCERRE broke outwards crossing the path of POWERFUL ZEN, was righted to track between foes off the second flight racing to the bend, gained some position between rivals after a half and continued evenly to late stages. DANCING ROCK was settled off the second flight outside foes early, was caught four wide racing into the turn and offered no rally while continuing evenly. MARQ'S TRY tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight racing into the bend and steadily retreated racing into the stretch. POWERFUL ZEN, shuffled back out of close quarters at the start, never gained contention. DECOMMANDER angled inwards to track off the second flight near the inside racing into the turn but steadily faded racing into the stretch. NO MO MOE WAS SCRATCHED AFTER BEING CAST IN THE GATE.
