RYAN'S FOR REAL raced to the rail, set the pace, was headed in the turn, came again and drew clear late. FAIRBANKS stalked the pace, put his head in front in the turn but couldn't get the winner. MR. CHAMP was taken back at the start, angled out in the second turn then closed willingly. GOOD AND LUCKY was reserved early, made a made brief bid and did not rally. MISTER TRIESTER stumbled badly at the start, raced wide into the first turn and drifted out in the stretch.
