**Footnotes**

GARIFINE, a bit reluctant to load in the gate before the start, broke sharply, set the pace along the inside racing into the turn, turned back a challenge from HAPMAN leaving the bend and held sway to the end under firm right handed encouragement. The latter broke inwards brushing MING GLO, was quickly righted to stalk just off the pacesetter, advanced to press the issue on the turn but proved no match in the final quarter. FLYING BY THE POLE, bumped at the start, settled just off the inside in the opening stages, shifted off the inside in upper stretch and improved his position four deep to late stages. STIG'S DEPUTY broke inwards bumping FLYING BY THE POLE, was righted to track just off the leaders along the inside racing into the turn but had no closing bid. MING GLO, brushed at the start, settled off the inside in early stages and never gained contention. DURAZNO was roused to gain a contending position outside a rival in the opening quarter but emptied out after a half. DUE TO A TELETIMER MALFUNCTION THE RACE WAS HAND TIMED.
