Footnotes

SHES GOT TO RUN, urged to secure a forward placing just outside the pacesetter, stalked that rival racing into the bend, made steady progress to wrest command entering upper stretch and drew away under some right handed encouragement and strong handling. GAMBLER FIVE, steadied a bit when caught in tight quarters at the start, gradually regained terms with the second flight while angling inwards, advanced along the rail on the turn into upper stretch and proved best of the others. STONE FREE broke outwards bumping PREMIUM CUT, was righted to track just off the first flight three deep racing into the turn, altered course avoiding TATY'S GOLD in upper stretch and continued evenly in late stages while earning a share. TATY'S GOLD was urged to the lead from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the inside racing into the turn, ducked out once headed by the winner in upper stretch and quickly gave way. PREMIUM CUT bobbled, then was bumped just after the start, gained a position in second flight racing well off the inside into the bend, continued between foes to upper stretch but offered no rally. BEA'S HARD SIX broke sharply, tracked the leaders five deep in the second flight racing to the bend and steadily faded while maintaining that path into upper stretch. GREY LIGHT was switched outside foes soon after the break, was caught six wide racing to the turn and soon dropped out.
