WORK ALL WEEK, a bit reluctant to load in the gate, broke readily to join the pace outside a rival, edged forward to a narrow advantage after the opening quarter to dictate the pace on a comfortable margin through the bend, forged clear under pressure nearing midstretch and extended that margin to the end under firm encouragement. GEORGIE MY BOY was urged to dispute the pace inside the eventual winner racing through the backstretch, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the leader in the final quarter but continued with interest to hold a rival for place honors. RADIANT DAY, unhurried between foes tracking the leaders from out of striking distance in the opening quarter, made some progress to advance on the leaders racing four wide into upper stretch and continued with interest to gain some position while failing to menace the winner. CHAMPAGNE TONY tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance along the inside racing to the turn, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. CAN'T STOP RAVIN was urged to gain a forward placing while shifting out three deep early, continued in pursuit of the eventual winner in that path through the turn and emptied out after a half. WINNINGCHEROKEE, caught four wide in the opening stages while dropping well off the pace, never gained contention. IOLANDA'S PERFECT settled in last while being guided to the rail in the opening stages, continued along the inside to the stretch but never gained contention.
