Footnotes

JUST BE THERE, in close attendance to the pace between foes from the outset, shied inwards avoiding close quarters in the opening sixteenth while exchanging some contact with CIELO SLEW, was righted to track the leaders outside that foe in the second flight racing to the bend, angled out four deep nearing upper stretch while moving to striking distance, shifted inwards a bit racing through the stretch but wrested command from SHANIA'S HOPE to prevail in time under steady right handed encouragement. The latter broke sharply, angled inwards forcing the pace three deep racing into the bend, shook clear in upper stretch but couldn't fend off the winner's charge. ZOOMIE ZOOMIE broke slowly, settled off the second flight near the inside, steadily drew into contention after a half, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes four wide nearing the furlong marker and continued with interest to improve her placing while gaining a share. CIELO SLEW, roused to contention soon after the break, was bumped, then squeezed between foes in the opening sixteenth, recovered to take up a tracking position inside a rival in the second flight, steadily drew into contention nearing upper stretch, was held up out of close quarters, then altered course three deep in upper stretch and lacked the needed final response. AUTUMN GLORY, a bit slow into stride, tracked off the second flight racing to the turn and never gained contention. OH GOLLY MS MOLLY bobbled while ducking in sharply at the start, was quickly righted while being urged to contention along the rail, exchanged some contact with CIELO SLOW near the five furlong marker, continued along the rail while pressing inside foes in the first flight racing into the bend but steadily faded from contention entering upper stretch. HATS N' HEELS was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the break while angling inwards, pressed the issue between foes on the bend and gave way quickly in upper stretch.
