Footnotes

DOUBLE LUCKY, unhurried between foes racing off the second flight in the opening quarter, made steady progress on the bend while shifting out a bit, angled four wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to prevail in time under firm left handed encouragement while finishing on his left lead. NAVAJO DAWN, on terms with the a rival on the pace from the outset, attended that rival's pace racing into the bend, pressed the issue racing into upper stretch to gain a narrow advantage, resisted when challenged nearing midstretch to regain the lead between calls late but just failed to fend off the winner. BLARNEY D'OR, forwardly placed along the inside tracking just off the pacesetter racing into the turn, shifted out three wide entering upper stretch while being urged to challenge, struck the front nearing the furlong marker but was outkicked by the top pair. LIL CHAMPLET, bumped at the start, was righted to gain a position outside a rival tracking off the first flight, shifted out racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. CELTIC LASSIE broke outwards bumping HIGHWAY ROBBERY, was settled three deep in the last flight racing to the turn and never gained contention. CREATIVE BLISS broke slowly, was guided to the rail early but never gained contention. HIGHWAY ROBBERY, bumped, then forced into LIL CHAMPLET at the start, never menaced thereafter. FANCY BELL showed quickly in front, set the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn and emptied out after a half.
