HELLO LOVE broke sharply, stalked just off the first flight along the rail under some reserve in the opening stages, came through close quarters nearing the furlong marker to challenge inside the pacesetter and wrested command in time under firm right handed prompting. TATY'S GOLD was urged to dispute the pace soon after the break while shifting to the inside, edged forward nearing upper stretch, resisted the winner's challenge to late stages but came up second best. ROSE MOUNTAIN tracked the leaders four deep as part of the second flight in the opening stages, angled in entering the turn to race between foes and continued with a steady bid three deep between rivals to late stages to close the gap on the top pair while narrowly prevailing for a share. JUDY'S QUEST was settled in last along the inside racing to the turn, swung out six wide entering upper stretch and made some belated progress while just missing for a share. HELLO AGAIN, reserved out of tight quarters while shifting inwards a bit just after the start, tracked well off the second flight into the bend, angled five wide in upper stretch and made some mild progress between foes. STONE FREE angled inwards to track the leaders between foes in the second flight, shifted out while making a brief advance nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the final stages. GO FOR THE MOON worked her way to the rail to track off the second flight racing into the turn, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response when roused along the inside racing through the stretch. OUR GIRL MAGIC settled near the inside early and never gained contention. PRAIRIE PRIZE joined the pace three wide in the opening stages, pressed the issue outside a rival racing into the turn and emptied out leaving midstretch.
