Footnotes

MOB BOSS raced unhurried four wide off the second flight in the opening stages, steadily drew into contention while angling inwards entering the turn, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, angled sharply to the rail leaving the three sixteenths marker to challenge inside foes and was roused clear in late stages. FEAR NOR FAVOR, reserved between foes off the second flight in the opening stages, steadily gained position outside a rival racing through the bend, angled six wide in upper stretch and made steady progress to prevail for place honors. OLD LOW DOWN tracked the pace between foes in the second flight early, moved to terms with the first flight three deep between foes entering the bend, continued to dispute the issue in that path past midstretch but was outkicked by the top pair. ABACO STORM worked his way to the rail early settling off the second flight, came around a tiring foe racing through the turn, shifted out in upper stretch to race three deep between foes but made an effort to improve position. GO POSSE GO, a bit slow to gather stride, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. MY KRYPTONITE went up from the break to prompt the pace outside a rival, dueled for command between foes on the turn into upper stretch and gave way late. DEAL OF A LIFETIME tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight early, shifted four wide racing into the bend while commencing an early advance, pressed the issue in that path to upper stretch and

gave way. PACKLEN'S BID settled between foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. TILLO was urged to the lead while shifting to the rail, dueled for command into upper stretch, lost some ground to the leaders leaving the three sixteenths marker, was checked off the winner when losing his path to that foe nearing the furlong marker and quickly dropped out. SHELLBARK, urged to a position inside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, retreated from contention early. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF TILLO LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
