Footnotes

TINNER was urged to secure the lead along the rail into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the second bend, turned back a rival to gain a clear advantage nearing midstretch and just held WILD JAZ in a prolonged drive. The latter took up a position stalking just off the first flight along the rail racing into the far turn, shifted out to split foes leaving midstretch, drew on terms with the pacesetter late but just failed to edge that foe. SAHM LIKE IT HOT, forwardly placed attending a rival's pace, continued between foes into the second bend, pressed the winner into upper stretch but weakened nearing the furlong marker. HE'S GOT TO RUN swerved out at the start, was collected to gain a position off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, then continued with a steady effort to improve position racing into the stretch. IMAGE OF GRANDEUR settled along the inside and made mild progress inside foes to gain some position while making no real impression. HENRY'S TIME tracked off the second flight outside foes racing to the far turn but never gained contention. NO LIP tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight racing to the far turn but offered no closing bid. HENDERSON settled into stride off the inside early but never seriously menaced. KING CRIMSON tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight for a half, bore out racing

through the far turn and quickly dropped out. CHRISTMAS PUNCH, forced wide into the first turn, quickly dropped out of contention and never menaced thereafter. HERE COMES HENRY angled in sharply while being urged to contend three deep racing into the first turn, continued three deep in second flight to the far turn and emptied out early.
