MANEKE settled early and saved ground, slipped through on the rail and drew clear late. SO GIFTED was jostled at the start, rallied while four wide and got up for place. DIAMOND ACCOUNT pressed the pace while inside, led late and was caught. MADDY'S BOBCAT raced close up early, split horses and was outfinished. GAMBLER'S PRIZE was bumped at the start, showed speed and was carried out in the turn. AMERICAN RACER was bumped at the start, dropped back and passed tiring rivals. ASESINA showed speed, drifted out badly in the turn and tired late. ROYAL KNOWLEDGE got off slowly and was no factor. MY CALABRESE checked while inside and tired late.
