PIRATESONTHELAKE stalked the pace, moved while three wide on the turn and took over late to win driving. GIANT HIT raced close up early, made a bid in the stretch along the inside but it was not enough. WHO LET THE CAT IN was bumped at the start the up rushed, was checked repeatedly and closed late when clear. TEA TAX rated in the middle of the pack, made a five wide move but was outfinished. HONORING was rushed to the lead and showed speed for a half then stopped. HAZARD'S JIMMY was bumped at the start, was void of early speed and made no rally. BIGBOYDANCING showed no speed while inside, and had no rally. PAWNSAY was void of early speed and trailed. ZOELING broke sharply, flashed brief foot then steadied and was eased in the stretch.
