Footnotes

GAIL'S JEWEL, reserved off the second flight near the inside early, shifted off the rail nearing the bend, commenced a steady advance on the turn splitting foes three deep, shifted to the four path avoiding KANIJA entering upper stretch while coming through close quarters and continued with a steady late response to just edge WAY SIDEINN in time under firm left handed encouragement. The latter joined the pace three deep from the outset, pressed the issue in that path into upper stretch, gained the lead leaving the furlong marker, resisted the winner's bid to the end and just failed to contain that foe. ART OF SURVIVAL angled to the inside disputing the pace racing through the backstretch, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. MISS PALATINE, bumped at the start, was settled while working her way to the inside early, angled out six wide racing through the stretch and found her best stride late to gain some position. SHARP TRIP flashed brief pace between foes near the inside in the opening stages and steadily faded along the rail racing into the stretch. CAMP FAIRFAX R N tracked the pace five wide in second flight early, chased the leaders in the four path racing through the turn and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. KANIJA stumbled at the start, was hustled to contend in the opening quarter while shifting out, pressed the pace briefly between foes entering the turn, drifted out into the winner's path leaving the quarter mile marker and quickly emptied out. SHAYLINS DANCER broke outwards bumping MISS PALATINE, was collected to track between foes in second flight while shifting out racing into the turn and retreated from contention early.
