**Footnotes**

MR. FLEXIBLE, reserved in hand while shifting to the inside in the opening stages racing well off the second flight, saved ground on the bend, shifted off the inside in upper stretch splitting foes three deep and produced a solid late response to strike the front in time under brisk right handed encouragement. NO GOOD DEED was settled in last along the inside in the opening quarter, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted out advancing between foes leaving the furlong marker, angled five deep near the sixteenth marker and found his best stride late to just miss. BARRACUDA BAY tracked off the second flight outside a rival under some reserve in the opening stages, made steady progress splitting foes on the turn to gain striking distance while shifting out four

wide in upper stretch, led between calls late but was just collared on the wire. COUNCIL OAK stalked just off the first flight between foes under rating racing into the bend, made steady progress to challenge three deep between foes into upper stretch but was just outkicked. STIG'S DEPUTY was urged to dispute the pace along the rail from the outset, dueled for command into upper stretch and yielded in the final sixteenth. ALL TANKED UP tracked the leaders along the rail in second flight under some reserve early, shifted out to bid between foes racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. HAPMAN was held up while angling inside to track off the second flight early, saved ground on the bend while racing in close quarters nearing upper stretch, then was shuffled a bit in tight quarters racing along the rail through the stretch. ROARIN MISSILE, close up three deep between foes in the opening stages, chased the leaders on the turn to upper stretch while being fanned four wide and had no final kick. MIGHTY RULE, in touch with the leaders four deep between foes in the opening stages, continued in that path through the turn and steadily faded racing into the stretch. UNO PECADOR broke sharply, forced the pace outside foes racing into the bend, drifted out after three and a half furlongs and gave way. DAGNABIT, urged along five wide racing into the turn in pursuit of the leaders, gave way after three furlongs.
