**Footnotes**

COPPER FOREST was urged to the lead from between foes from the outset, angled to the rail entering the first turn, dictated the tempo on a narrow margin into the far turn, shifted out nearing midstretch while under stout pressure to repel a bid from CARTOUCHE and turned back that foe under firm right handed encouragement. The latter, rated just off the first flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted out three deep midway through the far turn while being urged to challenge between rivals, drew on terms with the winner nearing midstretch, was floated out a bit by that foe leaving the furlong marker and came up second best. NINTH CLIENT was urged to gain a forward placing tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, came under pressure to force the issue racing into the far turn, couldn't match the winner nearing upper stretch and faded while continuing well enough to save a share. UNBRIDLED VICAR, reserved off the inside from just out of striking distance in the opening stages, moved to challenge while shifting out four wide between foes racing through the far turn but had no final response. INSTILL settled well out of striking distance early, swung outside after a half, was caught five wide racing into the far turn while making a brief bid but gave way abruptly in upper stretch.
