Footnotes

LUCK WITH A KISS broke sharply, was urged to the lead along the rail, shook clear of a rival racing into upper stretch to open a commanding advantage and just held the challenge of TAPILU under steady right handed pressure. The latter tracked just off the second flight in the opening stages, split rivals leaving the turn moving to contention, shifted outside a tiring foe in upper stretch and steadily closed the gap on the winner to the end. DANCE FOR PACO was settled in hand well off the inside in the opening quarter, steadily gathered momentum leaving the bend, shifted out four deep racing through the stretch and continued to improve position four deep to the end while gaining a share. LOST FORTY tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight, came under pressure chasing the winner on the turn but came up empty in upper stretch. TABLE GAMES was settled near the inside in the opening stages, shifted off the inside to race three deep between foes into upper stretch and made an effort to improve his position. FOUR LEFT FEET was a brief factor along the inside racing as part of the second flight, dropped off those foes to track the pace along the rail on the turn but lacked the needed closing response. MASTMAN swerved inwards a bit at the break, raced four deep in second flight in the opening stages, angled inwards to prompt the winner racing into the turn, couldn't match that foe after a half, drifted out in upper stretch and gave way. SHOTGUN LUKE tracked the pacesetter three deep in the second flight racing into the bend but steadily retreated entering upper stretch.
