Footnotes

LORD OF THUNDER tracked the leaders four wide as part of the second flight in early stages, made a steady, three wide advance to gain terms with the first flight racing through the bend, took over in upper stretch and held safe the challenge of BULLS FIRST TRICK under brisk left handed pressure. The latter tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside, angled four wide in upper stretch, closed the gap on the winner racing through the final stages but came up second best. JOY FROM PHOENIX ducked out at the start bumping RED PLAYS ROUGH, shifted outside in the opening quarter, came around foes five deep entering upper stretch but continued willingly for a share. RAILSPLITTER broke slowly, tracked the pace unhurried along the inside, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and improved his position to the end. CAPTAIN WOOD, shut off, bumped soundly by RED PLAYS ROUGH, then checked at the start, shifted out in upper stretch and passed outside tiring rivals. FABLE'S FINALE broke inwards, was righted to stalk just off the pacesetter, was urged to press that rival to upper stretch and gave way. INTENSLYCONFUZZLED was hustled to the lead along the inside, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. RED PLAYS ROUGH swerved out, bumped CAPTAIN WOOD at the start, was collected to chase between foes racing to the bend but emptied out nearing upper stretch. JIMMY'S IMAGE chased the leaders along the inside and emptied out nearing upper stretch.
