ROSE OF ASCOT, reserved in last along the rail dropping out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, gradually gathered momentum while switching out five deep in upper stretch and produced a steady late response to wear down the leaders, narrowly prevailing on the wire under energetic handling. LEMON CHILLER, within striking distance early tracking the pacesetter outside a foe in second flight, made steady progress to challenge the leader racing through the far turn, gained the advantage between calls in late stages but just failed to contain the winner. HOLY ROSIE was urged to the lead along the inside, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin into the far turn, resisted when challenged racing into upper stretch and continued to dispute the issue to the end. CHICAGO RUHLS tracked the pacesetter inside a rival in the second flight in the opening half but came up empty racing into the far turn. EL CHARMER broke awkwardly, tracked off the second flight while shifting off the inside racing to the backstretch but faded from contention early.
