Footnotes

KIPLING'S KING broke readily to gain the advantage along the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, forged clear when given his cue entering upper stretch and drew away under firm handling. TRY A LEMON DROP tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight, saved ground into upper stretch and continued with interest to prevail for place honors while failing to menace the winner. MR. MOSTLY, forwardly placed tracking just off the leaders in the opening stages, moved to challenge the leader three deep nearing upper stretch but steadily faded in late stages when failing to match that foe. RICHARD'S TUNE, bumped at the start, was quickly righted to gain terms with the first flight between foes, prompted the pacesetter racing into the bend and gave way after a half. HIGHFLYINGBLESSING broke outwards bumping RICHARD'S TUNE, dropped into last while being collected off that foe and never gained contention. HOME GROWN HERO tracked off the second flight in the opening stages, continued four deep through the turn and steadily faded entering the stretch.
