### Footnotes

TWINE FLIES set the pace from the inside on a clear lead and was not menaced in the run to the wire. RUPERT'S FIRE raced close up off the rail and gained the place in the run to the wire. SASSY BEAR lacked speed, angled to the middle of the track for the drive and rallied belatedly for a share. MISS SPRAGG raced close up just outside and weakened. PACIFIC SUNSET raced near the middle of the field and also weakened. JILL RABBIT was always outrun. EOLICA raced near the middle of the field and tired.
